ALL KEEP AND OTHER CHARGES DUE MUST BE SETTLED IN FULL AT THE TIME OF COLLECTION OF THE MARE AND/OR FOAL BY CLEARED FUNDS. WE ACCEPT CREDIT AND DEBIT CARDS.

Forms A properly completed Nomination Form and Vet's Declaration will be required for every Mare visiting the Stud, regardless of the Stud service being provided. These should be sent to the Stud prior to arrival of the mare.

Health Tests All mares must be swabbed for CEM and blood tested for EVA within 30 days prior to arrival and the certificates forwarded to the Stud. Mares will not be allowed onto the Stud without prior receipt of satisfactory test results, unless prior arrangement to swab at the stud has been made.

Passports All mares should have their ULN (Unique Life Number) in their passports, as well as up-to date Tetanus Toxoid and preferably Equine Flu and vaccination records. Mares must travel with there Passports.

Blacksmith Mares and foals will have their feet trimmed when necessary and the owner will be charged accordingly. All mares to have their hind shoes removed prior to arrival at the Stud. Unless prior arrangement for stud Farrier to attend the mare has been arranged.

Worming Mares and foals will be wormed every 4 to 6 weeks and the owner will be charged Accordingly.

Vet Treatments & Fees All expenses incurred for visits, examinations and medicines are payable on account monthly to the stud, unless the breeding vets package supplied by Maes Glas has been entered into, where a cheque for the appropriate amount must be supplied at time of arrival. In the event that emergency veterinary attention is necessary, all efforts will be made to contact the owner prior to treatment. However, if the owner is not available for whatever reason, Maes Glas Veterinary Practice will administer the treatment they consider to be most appropriate and in the best interests of The mare and/or foal and charge the owner's account accordingly.

Visiting Mares The Stud reserves the right to feed or stable grass mares, as they consider most beneficial to the care of the mare and/or foal. Mares at Phoenix National Stud will receive every possible care, attention and supervision but no responsibility can be taken for accident or Disease. All mares are tried and served at their owners' risk and no responsibility can be accepted for injury, damage or loss. The Stud reserves the right to refuse any mare without reason.

Please note that Phoenix National Stud operates according to the HBLB Codes of Practice on CEM, EVA, EHV and Guidelines on Strangles. As such, we will be unable to accept your mare onto the Stud without all necessary documentation and satisfactory health tests.

Also by submitting a nomination form to Phoenix National Stud you are agreeing to the above terms and conditions and are therefore bound into a contract.
